Creating a Pie Chart

Lesson Overview

Computer class is going to be a little more fun today. The teacher has brought in bags of Skittles[™] candy in an attempt to help you understand how a pie chart works. Before you can eat the candy, you have to separate the candies by color and then type your findings into your computer. You will then use a pie chart to determine the percentage of each color included in your bag of candy.

In this lesson, you will create a pie chart using the data from one bag of candy.




- 1. Using Microsoft Excel 2013, create a new Blank workbook.
- 2. Save the file as 6.1 Skittles in your My Excel Projects folder.
- 3. Key the data as shown in 6.1 Source Doc. A.
- 4. From the INSERT tab, Charts group, do the following:
 - a. Select cells A3 through B8
 - Choose the first 2-D Pie Chart option



- c. Position the chart under the data
- d. Click in the Chart Title, then change title to [Skittles Colors Per Bag] (as shown below)



- e. Change the colors of the slices of pie to correspond with the color of the candy
 - O Note: To do this, select only the piece of pie you want to change, go to Format Data Point, and choose the appropriate Fill Color
- f. Click anywhere in the legend, then change its position to Right
- 5. Proofread your work for accuracy and format, then resave the file.
- 6. Select all cells containing data and charts, then Print Preview your worksheet.
- 7. Your worksheet should look similar to 6.1 Source Doc. B.
- 8. Print a copy if required.
