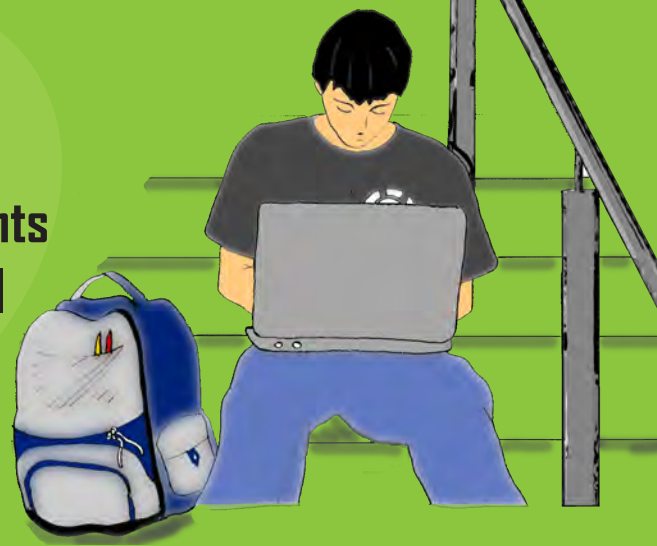

1 Never give out your password to anyone, except your parent or guardian.
